

Outside Shelter

The current aim of the PTA is to purchase and install a large shelter (200² Metres) to benefit the students during lunch / break times. This will be located in the area opposite the canteen, as shown on the photos. The total project cost is £23,500 including vat.

Project requirements are:

Funding - £12,000
